Dynamics of Urban St. George was conceived, in order to provide a balance between the body of existing literary work on the town of St. Georges, as opposed to the dearth of information on the technical aspect of this urban centre. With this in mind the author set about to provide a brief historical background of the town, from its beginning in 1650 as a French colonial outpost in the Caribbean, its evolution, and the intense rivalry between the French and the English during the wars of the 17th and 18th centuries for this prized possession, which was acquired from the native kalinagos by the colonisers through subterfuge and gun-power. The historical background set the scene for the growth of the town from 1650 to the present (2013), by looking, examining and analysing the town mainly from an Architectural and Urban Planning perspectives. This has been achieved by dissecting the town into its principal components which come together, and is unified in a comprehensive dramatic whole, which includes Topography, Urban Planning, Architecture and Location.
