

Classification, assignment, counseling, and guidance services neither identify offenders needs and interests nor encourage participation in appropriate programs. Academic education, occupational training, and work assignments do not prepare offenders for employment. Transitional programs do not receive enough attention and education and training programs have not been fully evaluated.
