

(2) The second period, extending from March 3, 1817, to July 31, 1894, was characterized in the beginning by a policy of elimination, of the addition of new methods and of transformation of old methods, from which was gradually evolved a system. (3) The third period, beginning July 31, 1894, and still subsisting, is chiefly distinguished from the second as inaugurating a readjustment and a reorganization of the second, the evolution being continued along the same essential lines.
